'An Element of Logic' DISTRIBUTED BY NEWMARKET MUSIC



The Tim Wilson trio was formed in 1996 and is inspired not only by the great saxophone trios of the past, as lead by players like Sonny Rollins and Joe Henderson, but also by the more recent recordings of Kenny Garrett, Dave Holland, Chris Potter, Branford Marsalis and Joe Lovano.

The ensemble draws upon a broad repertoire, including a large portion of originals contributed by all three members, as well as freshly arranged classic standards and lesser known compositions of various composers. The trio has performed at various venues around Melbourne including regular appearances at Bennetts Lane, and has played at both the Wangaratta Festival of Jazz, and the Melbourne International Jazz Festival.

The trio launched its ARIA nominated CD, 'An Element of Logic' in 2000, which was recorded at the ABC in April 1999 for Jim McLeod's 'Jazz Tracks', and is released through New Market music. Tracks from this CD have also been included on the New Market Music compilation CD 'Jazz in Melbourne', and on the Wangaratta Festival of Jazz CD. In 2001, the trio was awarded a Contemporary Music Tour Grant and undertook a national tour covering Melbourne, Sydney, Canberra, Adelaide, Perth, Hobart and Launceston.
